

## Code of Conduct for Senior Players

Predators Netball Club wishes netball to be an enjoyable and positive experience for all involved in the game. Please use these guidelines to support your club and fellow players in a manner that will enable you and others around you to enjoy your netball.

Ensure you are up to date with the latest laws of netball, understand and adhere to them. Encourage your team members to learn the rules of netball and play within them. Recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches and officials, who are usually volunteers. They give their time and resources to enable you to play netball. Publicly accept officials' judgements. Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials by anyone, both on and off court. Be a positive role model, treat other players and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you. Recognise fair play and applaud the good performances of all, including the opposition. Accept success and failure, victory and defeat equally. Use correct and proper language at all times. Encourage everyone to enjoy the sport of netball and understand that people have different motivations in playing the game.

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their age, gender, ability, cultural background, religion or sexual orientation.

Check the fixture list provided at the start of the season to ensure availability and flag up any issues regarding availability AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY.

Communicate pro-actively with your coaches and captain in ensuring you are available for fixtures and ensuring timely transport to and from the game is in place.

Recognise that netball is a squad game and that your coaches will make substitutions where they deem appropriate during a game.
